To attach a Questionnaire to a person attending a session:

- Hover over Work and select Session Groups
- Select the relevant Session Group
- Click on Sessions from the Attendances Tab on the left-hand side
- Select the relevant **Session Date**
- Select the Add Questionnaire icon to the right of the relevant contact
- Choose a Questionnaire<sup>\*</sup> and click **Select**
- Complete the form and click **Save**

To attach an Outcome to a person attending a session:

- Hover over Work and select Session Groups

- Choose an Outcome<sup>†</sup> and select **Add Outcome**
- Complete the form and select Add Outcome
