


How to Generate an IMD Statistic Summary

Indices of Multiple Deprivation (IMD) are used to rank the relative deprivation of small neighbourhoods in England across several domains, including income, employment, health and crime. You can use Views to report on the relative deprivation of the Participant and Venue postcodes collected within your account*.

To generate an IMD statistic summary:

- Hover over **Intelligence** and select **Statistic Summaries**
- Click on the **Plus** icon 
- Click on either the **Participants (IMD)** or the **Venues (IMD)** summary
- Enter a **Start Date** and **End Date**
- Add **Work Filters** if required
- Click **Apply** to run the report

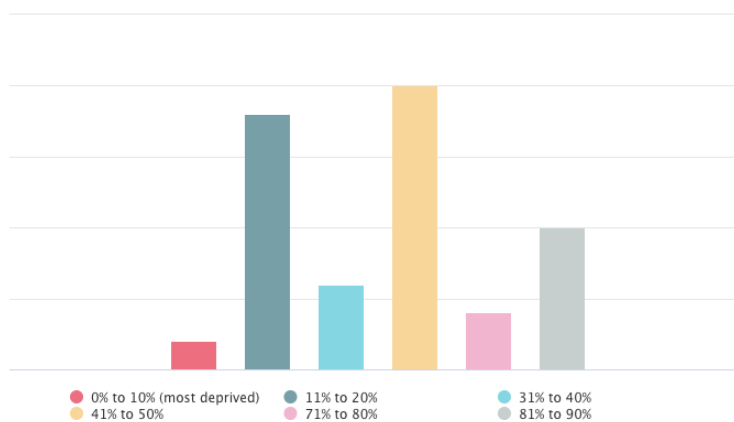
